## JOB PURPOSE

As a Framework Manager you will be expected to lead frameworks on behalf of our client members.

You are required to provide excellent service to members of the consortia through the efficient management of procurement processes in order to appoint contractors and suppliers to improvement and maintenance contracts (predominantly construction.)

You will deliver an innovative and value-for-money procurement service by embedding category strategies and focusing on the needs of internal and external stakeholders.

Additionally, you will familiarise and be able to advise members of their obligations and requirements under various standard forms of Construction Contract including, but not limited to, JCT and NEC suites.

## KEY RESPONSIBILITIES AND ACCOUNTABILITIES

- Responsible for carrying out spend analysis reviews with members in order to identify and develop savings opportunity assessments, undertaking benchmarking where possible to support this.
- Maintaining the procurement pipeline for the accountable category area. Liaise with key stakeholders within the business divisions, and ensure the pipeline is continually reviewed to ensure it remains consistent with the strategic aims and objectives of the business and of any significant development in the respective supply markets.
- Plan and monitor workloads against the teamwork plans and ensure all activity is effectively resourced and carried out efficiently and compliantly.
- Liaise and work collaboratively with the Procurement Manager to identify and develop frameworks according to member needs and procurements that support the business plan.
- Lead and advise on framework call off methodology to support members.
- Drive operational efficiencies, improve customer service and, where appropriate, lead on the production of corresponding business cases.
- Develop and maintain effective relationships with members and their stakeholders.

- Keep abreast of developments in key supply markets and establish senior management relationships with Framework contractors/suppliers.
- Accountable for promoting and embedding ESG strategy in framework contracts and the ongoing management of these initiatives, supporting the ESG manager where required.
- Undertake additional duties appropriate to the role and/or grade.

### Working with the Framework Team, including:

- Expressions of interest and invitations to tender for mini competitions from frameworks.
- Developing selection models for direct selections from frameworks.
- Developing scheme cost models and benchmarking data.
- Evaluating tenders, direct award models, and material supply information to advise members of the optimum selection proposals.
- Arranging and attending scheme kick start meetings with members, suppliers, and contractors.
- Using web-based systems in the management of mini competition processes.
- Using web-based systems to set up schemes for transacting works.
- Maintaining catalogue data for web-based systems use.
- Arranging and participating in Framework Management Events.
- Interpreting member training and coaching needs on a best-fit basis.
- Undertaking benchmarking.
- Participating in Framework Management events and EN: Connect.
- Filling out and publishing (where required) notices under transparency requirements of current and future procurement legislation.
- Taking on responsibility for developing and mentoring junior/new members of staff.
- Working alongside other teams to promote wider businesses and showcase achievements for the purpose of business development and marketing.
- Taking on responsibility for personal development, including attending webinars, self-guided learning and networking, as well as completing all mandatory training as required.
- Any other related duties as required by your line manager.
